#### Foreword

In this volume I tried to put forward the case-law of Human Rights Committee, African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights and the Inter-American organs, both the Commission and the Court all of which have vital roles in the protection of environment taking into consideration the lack of a specific convention on this matter.
